

# WILD KO WATER ORGANOLEPTIC – SENSORIAL ANALYSIS

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**Date:** December 14, 2018.

**Place of Origin:** Fundo Coreo, Los Ángeles.

**Region:** Bio Bio.

**Extraction depth:** 50 metres.

**Flow rate:** 32 litres per second.

**Extraction temperature:** 7 degrees Celsius.

**Freshness:** it has a pleasant freshness and delicate palate sensation.

**Effervescence:** No.

**Translucence:** Highly vivid and natural shine at the eye.

**Smell:** Nose-neutral, with slight touches of dry leaves, grass and lemon skin.

**Acidity:** Very delicate natural acidity, finishing with a pleasant sweet sensation, typical of its low mineral content

**Flavour:** It has a low mineral content, specially low sodium, making it a light water with soft mouth texture.

**Structure:** It is a quite balanced water, with uniform structure moving lightly through the mouth.

**Smoothness:** this water moves smoothly and with delicacy in the mouth.

**Persistence:** It has medium persistence, marked by a slightly sweet aftertaste.

## **Tasting Note:**

This is a water with limpid and shining appearance. Aromatically neutral, with light grass, dry leaves and lemon skin flavour. In the mouth, it moves lightly, fresh, with soft texture and citric and herbaceous flavours. In finishing, it is slightly sweet with medium persistence in the mouth.
